Main Directory Settings

Shortcode: *Copy and paste this shortcode onto the page where the directory should be displayed. The [Multiple Directories Add-on](#) will let you create and display up to 50 directories, each with its own settings.*

Sort Field: *This field will always be shown first on each listing. You may sort by Last Name or Display Name. If Last Name is selected, it will sort by last name but still display the full name. The [Custom Sort Field Add-on](#) will allow you to sort the directory by any meta field you wish.*

Directory Type: *"Alphabet Letter Links" shows only the users for the selected letter. "Single Page Directory" shows all users on one page. Choose "Alphabet Letter Links" if page load time is an issue.*

Directory Search: *Show a search box at the top of your directory to search by last name or display name depending on the Sort Field. The [Meta Fields Search Add-on](#) lets the user search by ANY user meta field(s) you specify. The [Hide Directory Before Search Add-on](#) hides directory listings until a search has been run.*

Exclude or Include Users With These Roles: *"Include" creates a directory in which ONLY users with the selected roles are shown. "Exclude" hides all users with the selected roles. If no users are selected this setting will not be applied.*

Exclude Include

Exclude or Include These Users: *"Include" creates a directory in which ONLY the selected users are shown. "Exclude" hides the selected users. If no users are selected this setting will not be applied. Note: Selected users will be included or excluded even if their user role was selected for hiding. The [Exclude User Filter Add-on](#) allows you to exclude users based on a meta field value or membership status.*

Exclude Include

Debug Mode: Off On *When debug mode is "on," a set of debug statements will be shown for admins "ONLY" at the top of the User Directory. Leave debug mode "off" unless instructed to turn on.*

Listing Display Settings

Show avatars: *Show avatars in your directory. Note: Some themes enforce a certain avatar shape. In those cases, DUD will "not" alter the site-wide avatar shape settings.*

Avatar Size: px *96px is the WordPress and DUD default avatar size.*

Avatar Padding: px *Avatar Padding: The amount of space (in pixels) between the avatar on the left and the rest of the user information in your listing on the right. The default for DUD is 120px.*

Link to Author Page: *Hyperlink the user name and avatar to the user's WordPress author page.*

User Name Display Format: *First Last shows the user name like "Sally Smith." Last, First shows it like "Smith, Sally."*

Listing Border: *Show a border around or between each listing.*

Border Thickness: **Border Color:**

Listing Font Size: px **Space Between Listings:** px *Space Between Listings: how much space (in pixels) to insert between each directory listing.*

Directory Totals Settings

Directory Totals: *Display the number of members in the directory and/or the number of search results returned. When set to "Show User & Search Result Totals," the total members will be shown by default and the total search results will be shown when a search is run.*

Text After Number of Members: *Customize the text that follows the number of members. Default is "total members."*

Text After Number of Search Results: *Customize the text that follows the number of members when a search is run. Default is "search results." This setting only applies if your directory has a user search and you have chosen to show search result totals.*

Position: *Choose where to show the directory totals.*

Font Size: px

Border: *Show a dividing border below the directory totals (if showing the totals at the top) or above the directory totals (if showing the totals at the bottom).*

Alphabet and Pagination Link Settings

LETTER LINKS

This section only applies if you have selected "Alphabet Letter Links" as the directory type or you have installed the Alpha Links Scroll add-on.

Letter Links Font Size: px **Letter Links Spacing:** px *Letter Links Spacing: how much space (in pixels) to insert between each of the alphabetic links.*

Letter Link Color: **Letter Link Clicked Color:** *Letter Link Color: the color of the alphabet letter links. Leave blank to use your theme's default link color.*

Letter Link Clicked Color: *Letter Link Clicked Color: the color of the alphabet letter link that is currently being viewed. Leave blank if you do not want to highlight the selected letter link.*

PAGINATION

Pagination works for both Single Page & Alphabet Letter Links directory types. On Letter Links directories, pagination will only be shown for a selected letter if that letter has more listings than the number of users per page.

Number of Users Per Page: *Enter a number here to activate pagination on your directory. If you do not want pagination, leave this blank. NOTE: Turning on pagination will automatically uncheck (deactivate) the Alpha Links Scroll add-on if it is installed and activated.*

Show Pagination Links:

Pagination Top Position: *This only applies if your directory is showing the last name/display name search box, or you have installed the Meta Fields Search add-on.*

Pagination Link Font Size: px

Padding Top: px *Increase the padding above the pagination links. Set to 0 or leave blank for no additional padding.*

Padding Bottom: px *Increase the padding below the pagination links. Set to 0 or leave blank for no additional padding.*

Pagination Link Color: **Pagination Link Clicked Color:** *Pagination Link Color: the color of the numeric page links. Leave blank to use your theme's default link color. Pagination Link Clicked Color: the color of the page link that is currently being viewed. Leave blank if you do not want to highlight the selected page link.*

It is recommended that the pagination link colors match their letter link counterparts when using an Alphabet Letter Links directory type.

Meta Fields Settings

INSTRUCTIONS

This is where you will build the content of your directory. The key name listbox(es) below contain the names of the user meta fields available for use in your directory. Find the meta key names corresponding to the user profile fields you want to display, then copy and paste each one into the Meta Key Name input fields. The Address and Social Meta Fields sections may be used instead if you would like DUD to format them for you.

Show Email Addr: **Show Website:** *Check the boxes to show these built-in WordPress user profile fields in the directory. If you wish to show an email or website address that is stored in a meta field instead, do "not" check these boxes, and simply add the email and/or website meta field key names below.*

WordPress Meta Key Names:

A listing of the meta key fields for reference only. You must type or copy & paste the key name into the appropriate meta field below for the key field value to be displayed in the directory. Enter the key name using the SAME capitalization shown in the key names list.

USER META FIELDS: *Use the dropdown to show extra meta fields or hide unneeded ones. If you hide a meta key name/label field, that field will automatically be cleared.*

Layout Settings

Display Order:

Drag the list items up or down using your mouse to rearrange the display order. Note that the Sort Field (Last Name or Display Name) will always be the first field shown. For horizontal directories, the order from top to bottom will be shown from left to right (you can show directory listings in a horizontal tabular format with the [Horizontal Layout Add-on](#)).
